## A Seminar for Parents

### Caught In The Middle

Divorce is a very stressful experience, especially for children. Required by the Superior Court of Chatham County, this four-hour educational program focuses on the unique needs of children during this time of change. Professionals from Parent and Child's Family Counseling Center will help parents learn to recognize the typical reactions of children and to develop skills to help children cope with their emotions.

### Registration and Attendance

On-site registration for the seminar will be 15 minutes prior to the start of the session. The program will begin promptly. Participants who arrive more than 20 minutes late will not be allowed to attend. Individuals who leave early will not be given credit. Upon completion, a Certificate will be given to the participant and the original will be forwarded to the Superior Court Administrator's Office to verify attendance. (There will be a \$10.00 charge for replacement certificates.) **Childcare is not provided and children cannot attend sessions.**

### Fees

The fee for the program is **\$45.00 Money Order, Credit Card, or Debit Card (VISA and MASTER CARD only)**. Payment is due prior to admission in the class. The Court shall either provide payment for indigent parties to complete the seminar or shall waive such requirement. The court must provide written certification of the waiver.

### Exemptions from Program

You may be exempt from the program if you reside more than 50 miles from Savannah, have already attended this or a similar program, or are in counseling with a professional therapist who will attest to covering this material with you. Documentation is required. An individual is not required to attend this seminar if:

- Service of process was satisfied by publication and the whereabouts of one of the parties cannot be determined;
- One of the parties to the marriage at the time of the action is serving a sentence in the Department of corrections;
- The youngest child of the parties is within six months of his or her eighteenth birthday;
- One of the parties to the proceeding does not live in this state; or
- The parties have been living separate and apart for more than five years.

Once written documentation has been provided to Parent and Child a Certificate of completion will be given.
